Main Tasks / Responsibilities

Interns participate in all-office activities (site visits, lectures, in-house special events, and work related social events) while working on project teams and becoming familiar with US architectural practices. During the six month internship each Intern is expected to prepare and give a presentation of his/her work to the office. Internship positions rotate throughout the year with only one Intern starting at one time. This ensures that each Intern will have individual attention as they enter the training group of more experienced Interns. Interns are given access to individual computer/drafting stations and computer software (including software for AutoCAD, word processing, spreadsheets, 3D modeling, document publishing, lighting simulation, etc).

Key Objectives of Training

To provide experience and exposure to the many facets of architectural practice. Interns assist project teams and may gain experience with schematic design, AutoCAD, model-making (firm possesses in-house model shop), construction documents, and presentation projects. Significant experience and hands-on training is required to successfully become a licensed architect. Training is oriented to prepare Interns for such a track.

Methods of Training

Interns have the opportunity to attend construction site visits, a bi-monthly in-office speaker series, and weekly whole-office design critiques. Interns are also offered a weekly lunchtime lecture series, which is devoted to a wide variety of architectural subjects. During the six-month internship each Intern is expected to prepare and lead a presentation of their work to the entire office.
